Lombok hosted the International Festival of Bamboo Architecture. The best installations were judged by a team of curators; Budi Pradono, IAI Jay Subiakto, Asmudjo Jono Irianto, Dipl.Ing. and Christoph Tönges. The Festival theme "Re-Design the World with Bamboo" aim, was to develop the creative economy on Lombok Island by utilizing local materials and increasing the value of keeping a "sustainable environment" said Chairman of the Indonesian Institute of Architects – West Nusa Tenggara Rahman Wibisono. Participants were from various backgrounds, including professionals and student architects, landscape architecture, contractors and developers.
